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INTRODUCTION

Kids Telescope Al-Isra' Wal Mi'raj Journey is a great DIY teaching tool for kids to learn about the journey of Al-Isra' Wal Mi'raj. It provides a visual representation of the journey.

WHAT YOU NEED

- 1. Scissors
- 2. Glue and Double Sided-Tape
- 3. A4 paper (Preferably black but you can use any colour)
- 4. A4 Transparent Acetate Sheets (Normally use for cover binder)
- 5. Print outs (https://www.thefamilystorybox.com/free-downloads)
- 6. Markers and Colour Pencils



INSTRUCTIONS



1.Complete the printouts, trace, cut and paste on the A4 paper. You can write down manually on the A4 paper if you do not have the printouts.

Make sure to glue the edges nicely.



3.Roll the A4 paper with pasted labels and stick the long side end edge using double-sided tape.

2. Cut the acetate sheets into strips and stick the end edge. Ensure the strips are long enough to fit in the circle. Stick the word Muhammad (saw) on the strip.

> Make sure to give space so that the acetate strip can move easily.

4.Fit the circle strip into the rolled A4 paper, and you are ready for storytelling!

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
